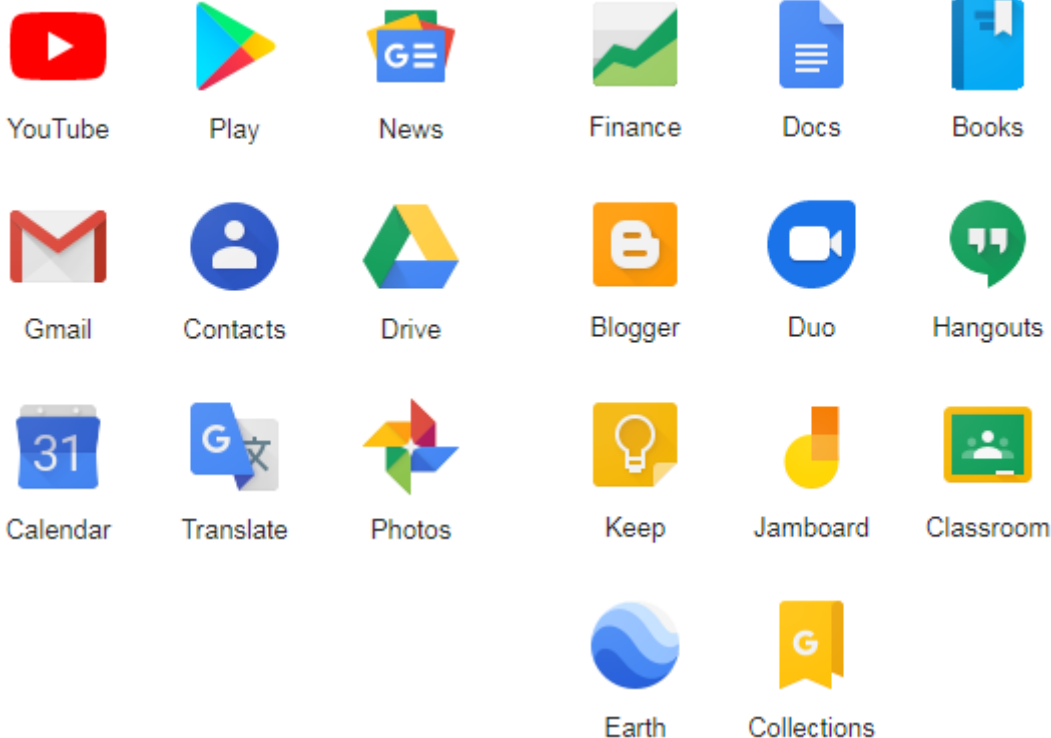




Google Level 1 ICT Certificate
