# The Bulmershe Sixth Form



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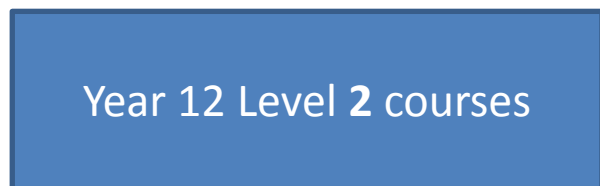
- Small and safe environment, all your teachers will know you very well

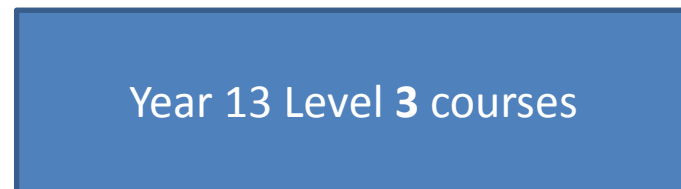
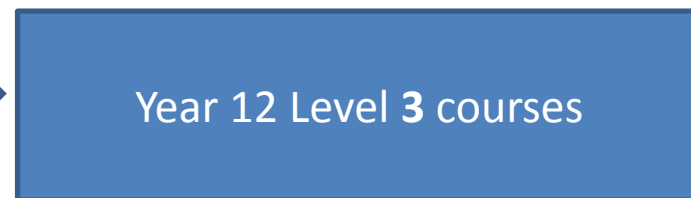


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Eng/Maths grade 3 plus

# Level 3 Courses



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We offer AS/A level course and Vocational courses.

AS/A level	Vocational courses
More emphasis on exams End of Yr 12 –AS exams End of Yr 13 – A2 exams	Linear courses which are 2 year commitments Mixture of internal /external coursework with exams

You can mix and match vocational and A level courses. For example:  
Physics, Maths, ICT and Business

Both courses are accepted by universities, apprenticeships and work places

# Subject Specific Entry Requirements



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## Level 3 Courses

**Science:** GCSE higher student, a grade B with grade 6 in maths

**Maths:** GCSE higher student, a grade 6

**English:** GCSE higher student, a grade 5

**MFL:** a grade B

**ICT, History, Geog,** Preferably a B in the subject

**Drama, Media, Psychology, RS:** Preferably a B in English

Individual conversations will need to take place if students want to study subjects not taken at GCSE

The entry requirement for all L3 courses are Eng/Maths grade 4 with **3 other A\*- C grades**

# Government Changes to A levels



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From September 2015 there are some changes to level 3 A level courses that have been brought in nationally by the government.

A small selection of subjects will adopt a linear approach meaning that they are 2 year commitments with no AS exam

**Most** of our subjects will continue to offer the AS exam at the end of the year 12. These AS exams are stand alone qualifications and hold no bearing for the outcome of the A2 exam.

We feel that AS exams act as a good measuring indicator for the end outcome in year 13.

# Application process



All students can apply to join the 6<sup>th</sup> form online

All Year 12 students are expected to study 3/4 level 3 courses or ALL level 2 courses

Deadline for applying - **Friday 10<sup>th</sup> Feb**

All internal students will be interviewed prior to joining the 6<sup>th</sup> form – **Beginning of March**

External students will be interviewed on **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March**

Acceptance letters will be given in early April to successful students
