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# FAQ

*“Are there any entry requirements for this course?”*

To access this course you will need to be over 19 years old (as of 31st Aug 2015) and have been a resident of the EU for at least 3 years (unless you have refugee or asylum seeker status). You should be able to read and write in English and have a basic understanding of maths so that you can support children with their learning.

*“I’ve got additional learning needs & need extra support ... who do I speak to?”*

## Transition Topics

- **Understanding** the changes in children’s stresses, anxieties, self-esteem, feelings & peer-pressure plus parental worries when children start secondary school
- **Supporting you and your child** including preparation before September, the importance of independence in planning and preparation, building resilience, problem-solving techniques and passing on any school specific arrangements

## Social Media Safety Topics

- **Understanding** sexting, cyberbullying, online grooming and other concerns parents have around social media
- **Supporting you and your child** including setting parental rules, healthy use of IT, social media privacy settings and where further help can be obtained
